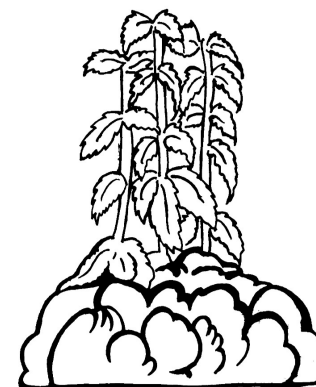


Homework

We will try to:

- support the school in matters of behaviour and with homework.
- Make sure our child comes to school dressed in the correct school uniform and bringing all they need for the day ahead e.g. homework, PE kit etc.
